Candidates for First Holy Communion and Confirmation are required to participate in faith formation for two years leading up to the reception of the sacrament. This means that if you are seeking First Holy Communion or Confirmation for your child, they must be registered for PSR or a Diocesan approved Catholic school in 1st grade or 6th/7th grade.

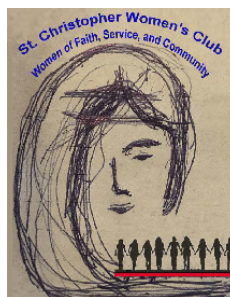
