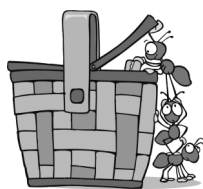


OSU \$25,000 ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABLE THROUGH THE CATHOLIC FOUNDATION:
