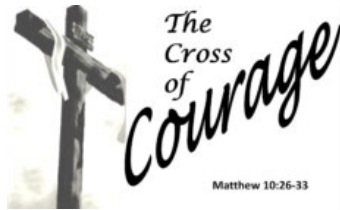

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

There was once a story of a pastor who gave a beautiful homily on “loving thy neighbor” which all the parishioners enjoyed. The pastor received many compliments that weekend. The following weekend, however, he gave the same homily word-for-word. Some parishioners wondered why for a moment, but didn’t think anything of it until the pastor gave the same homily a third week, then a fourth week. Finally, someone from the parish asked the pastor why he was giving the same message over and over again, to which he said “I’m going to keep saying it over and over until you all put it into practice!”

This story is a cute introduction for me to continue to ask, solicit, plea, and still beg for your participation in the Bishop’s Annual Appeal. We are down 20% to last year’s participation rate of which was 26%. This means that 74% of us are turning our backs on the poorest of our brothers and sisters and future needs of our diocese, including the formation of future priests. We, at St. Christopher, have been lucky thus far not to share a resident pastor with other parishes in a cluster like so many other parishes. If you have not made a pledge to this year’s Appeal, please do so this weekend.

Once again, a big thank-you to all who have worked long hours of volunteering for this year’s Festival. Numbers should be tallied soon, once bills have been paid.
