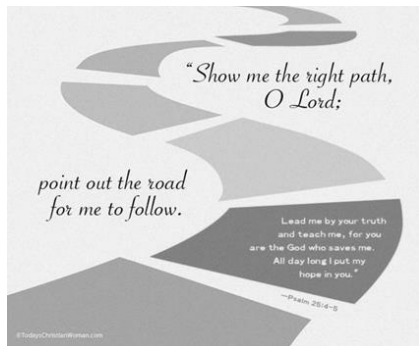

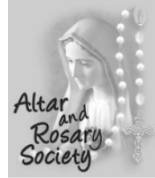


This week – October 1, 2017: Mary in the Qur'an: Marian Piety and early Islamic Belief – The Qur'an, much like the New Testament, regards Mary as a central figure

in the unfolding of God's providential ordering of human history and recounts many stories of her life and of her son Jesus. Speaker, Dr. Sean Anthony, associate professor of Arabic and Islamic Studies at the Ohio State University.
Looking ahead – October 8, 2017: Browsing in Solomon's Library, The book of Proverbs begins with Solomon's name, as someone who epitomized ancient wisdom. But this book is grounded in a larger world outside ancient Israel, and reacts to that non-Israelite world. There were other collections of proverbs, and even other Jobs who suffered outside Israel, and browsing these other texts helps us understand the biblical books of Proverbs, Job and Ecclesiastes. **Sam Meier**, Professor Meier received his Ph.D. from Harvard University (1987) in Hebrew and Semitic Languages and Literatures. He began teaching at the Ohio State University in 1986 in the Department of Near Eastern Languages and Cultures.
